

Transitions Carve-Out Waiver Program

The Transitions Carve-Out Waiver benefit package consists of nursing services, personal care assistance services and/or skilled therapy services, and waiver-specific services such as home modifications, home-delivered meals, adult day health care, respite care, supplemental transportation, adaptive/assistive devices, and emergency response systems.

The Transitions Carve-Out Waiver program is designed to meet the needs of consumers who are age 60 and older. Eligibility criteria requires having either an intermediate or skilled level of care need.

This waiver is not open to new enrollees. This means you cannot apply for enrollment directly onto the Transitions Carve-Out Waiver. You must first be on the Ohio Home Care Waiver and be “transitioned” to the Transitions Carve-Out Waiver program due to turning 60 years old.

Who administers the Transitions Carve-out Waiver program?

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services administers this waiver program. It contracts with a case management agency, CareStar, to provide case management services.
