

# Ohio Temporary Ramp Project - For Transitions, Independence, and Inclusion



**The Ohio Temporary Ramp Project** makes temporary aluminum ramps available to Ohioans covered by Medicaid. To receive a ramp, an individual must be in need of an accessible entryway to return home safely from a nursing home or rehabilitation facility.

Other individuals who cannot exit their homes independently may also be eligible. When the temporary ramps are no longer needed, the parts can be re-used to serve another individual.
