

Blood Lead Screening Requirements: Get Your Child Tested Today!

Take this card with you to your next doctor's visit. If your doctor has questions, they can contact Provider Relations (800) 686-1516.

MANDATORY SCREENINGS:

- » **12 and 24 months:** All Medicaid-eligible children 12 and 24 months of age **MUST** have a blood lead screening test. [Required by Ohio Administrative Code 5160-14-03 (J).]
- » **36 and 72 months:** Medicaid-eligible children between 36 and 72 months of age **MUST** have a blood lead screening test, unless there is documentation of a previous screening.

GET A TEST AT ANY VISIT: A blood lead screening test can be ordered or completed during any visit to a doctor's office. If you don't think your child has been tested, be sure to ask the doctor at your next visit.

RISK ASSESSMENT QUESTIONNAIRE: This is **NOT** an acceptable substitute for a blood lead screening test.
