

Who is eligible to enroll in a MyCare Ohio plan?

You are eligible to enroll in a MyCare Ohio plan if you:

- live in one of the following counties: Butler, Clark, Clermont, Clinton, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Delaware, Franklin, Fulton, Geauga, Greene, Hamilton, Lake, Lorain, Lucas, Madison, Mahoning, Medina, Montgomery, Ottawa, Pickaway, Portage, Stark, Summit, Trumbull, Union, Warren, Wayne, or Wood; **and**
- have Medicare Parts A, B and D; **and**
- have full Medicaid coverage; **and**
- are 18 years of age or older at time of enrollment.

You cannot enroll in a MyCare Ohio plan if you:

- have a delayed Medicaid spenddown.
- have other third party creditable health care coverage except for Medicare.
- have intellectual or other developmental disabilities and receive services through a waiver or Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF-IID).
- are enrolled in PACE (Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly).

Additionally, you have the option not to enroll in a MyCare Ohio plan if you:

- are a member of a federally recognized Indian tribe;
- have been determined by the County Board of Developmental Disabilities to qualify for their services; or
- are 18 years of age and receiving foster care or adoption assistance under Title IV-E, in foster care or an out-of-home placement, or receiving services through the Ohio Department of Health's Bureau for Children with Medical Handicaps (BCMh).

Will I have any cost after I enroll in a MyCare Ohio plan?

There is no additional premium or deductible with MyCare Ohio. If you currently pay your Part B premium for Medicare, or have a spenddown or patient liability for your Medicaid benefits, you will continue to be responsible for those expenses.

You may have a copayment for some outpatient prescription drugs.
