

**Certain Medicaid beneficiaries, however, are excluded from Medicaid managed care membership or are not required to enroll in a Medicaid managed care plan (i.e., membership is voluntary), as noted below:**

**Beneficiaries who are EXCLUDED from Medicaid managed care plan membership:**

- » Medicaid eligible Individuals on home and community based waivers
- » Medicaid eligible Individuals that are institutionalized
- » Individuals eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare
- » Individuals eligible for Medicaid that have a spend-down
- » BCMH (Bureau for Children with Medical Handicaps) children diagnosed with cancer, cystic fibrosis, or hemophilia\*

**Beneficiaries who are NOT REQUIRED TO ENROLL in a Medicaid managed care plan:**

- » Individuals under 19 years of age and are receiving title IV-E federal foster care maintenance
- » Individuals under 19 years of age that are in foster care or other out of home placement
- » Individuals under 19 years of age are receiving title IV-E federal adoption assistance
- » Individuals under 19 years of age that receive services through BCMH.

*\* The exclusion of children diagnosed with cancer, hemophilia, and cystic fibrosis that are enrolled in BCMH will end as of 6/30/2014. Effective 7/1/2014, families of these BCMH children will have the ability choose managed care if they feel it is in the best interest of their child.*
