ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Steps required for enrollment

- Eligible practices may visit the Ohio Department of Medicaid website at <http://medicaid.test.ohio.gov/Providers/PaymentInnovation/CPC.aspx#1612552-cpc-enrollment>, and click on the link labeled “Enroll here.” This will take them to the 1-page application for enrollment into the Ohio CPC program. This link will go live on October 1st of 2016.
- The enrollment page will look like this:

- All fields must be completed and the page must be “submitted”. Closing the page prior to completion will not constitute an application, and applications must be completed within a single visit. Entries will not be saved if closed without submission
- A pop-up will confirm successful submission, as well as an email to the point of contact listed in the application

Enrollment timing

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- Practices will enroll in Medicaid CPC between October 1st and October 31st of 2016
- Enrolling should take less than 30 minutes if your information is gathered in advance of enrollment

Information required to enroll

- In order to apply for enrollment, practices must provide:
 - Practice data:
 - Practice name
 - NPI
 - Practice Group ID
 - Information for a single point of contact for the CPC program:
 - Name
 - Email
 - Phone
 - Mailing address
 - Practices must attest to the following commitments:
 - To share necessary data with the state and payers
 - To participating in learning activities
 - To meeting start-up activity requirements within 6 months
 - Practices must attest to the accreditations they have achieved, from the following list:
 - NCQA II
 - NCQA III
 - URAC
 - AAAHC
 - Joint Commission
 - None of the above
 - Practices must indicate whether or not they have applied for CMS's Medicare CPC+ program
 - Practices must indicate whether any of their locations has been accepted to Medicare CPC+
