

- *The Core Benefit Package* is designed to meet the basic home care needs of most consumers who require up to 14 hours of nursing and/or daily living services per week.
- *The Ohio Home Care Waiver Benefit Package* is designed to meet the home care needs of consumers whose medical condition and/or functional abilities would qualify them for Medicaid coverage in a nursing home or hospital. In addition to the core services of nursing, daily living, and skilled therapies, waiver services include:
  - Home-delivered meals
  - Emergency response systems
  - Home modifications
  - Supplemental adaptive/assistive devices
  - Adult day health services
  - Out-of-home respite
  - Supplemental transportation
  - Nutrition/social work counseling
  - Care coordination
- *The Transitions Waiver Benefit Package* provides the identical services, providers, and administration as the Ohio Home Care Waiver benefit package but serves consumers who were transferred from the Ohio Home Care Waiver because they were identified as having an ICF-MR (intermediate care facility for people with mental retardation or developmental disabilities) level of care.
