

Download IAF Software (Update for existing users)

Use this download if you **already** have IAF data on your computer. This download will leave existing IAF data unaltered.

Step A. IMPORTANT: Before attempting to download the IAF software, please print the download installation instructions on this page. Click the **File > Print** menu on the toolbar and click the **OK button** when the Print dialog box appears.

Step B. Once you have printed the installation instructions, and AFTER you have completed installation steps one through six, **download** the installation file, IAFSetup.iaf, by clicking this link: ([version 2.0](#))

Versions previous to the above version of the State of Ohio ICF-IID software are no longer supported or distributed. Please contact Josh Anderson at (614) 387-0576 if you are unable to download the new software.

(Please read the following instructions before attempting to install.)

In order to make the installation of the new ICF-IID software as simple as possible, it has been packaged as a single executable file, which will install the software when opened. However, Web server security policy prevents us from deploying this file with an .exe (executable) extension. Therefore, you will need to follow this simple process to download and install (**You may find these instructions easier to follow if you print this page first**):


1. Right Click on the **Start button** which is usually located at the lower-left on your Windows desktop screen, and then left click on the **Explore** menu item.

The following instructions apply only to Microsoft's **Vista** users:

Instead of the start button you might see a small window symbol at the same location as the start button. Right click on that and then left click on the Explore menu item.

2. Left click on the C: drive and then double click on the IAFSetup folder on the C: drive.

3. Right click on the IAF Setup.exe file and select **delete** from the dropdown menu.

4. Left click the Start button, which is usually located at the lower-left on your Windows desktop screen, select Settings, then select and click on Control Panel, double click the 'Add/Remove Programs' icon.

Vista users should left click on the small window icon instead of the start button. Then they should left click on the Control Panel, double click on the Control Panel Home, double click on Programs and double click on Uninstall a Program.




5. Select the **ICFMR** entry and click the **remove** button.

Vista users should click the Uninstall button.

Follow the on-screen instructions until the Remove Program is completed, then close the Add/Remove Programs folder as well as the Control Panel folder.

Vista users, for any security warnings select "Allow".



6. Download the installation file, IAFSetup.iaf, by clicking the download link at the top of the page in Step B.


7. To start downloading the installation file, click on the **Save** button. When the dialog box appears, click the "Save in" dropdown box and then the (C:) drive. In the larger box just below the "Save in" box, search for the folder named IAFSetup and double-click on it to open it. Click the **Save** button to save the downloaded file, IAFSetup.iaf, to the IAFSetup folder. Downloading this file may take as long as 10 minutes depending on your download speed.

Vista users, while you are downloading the IAF Software, if you get any security messages select the "Allow" option to continue with the installation.


8. Close the web page you are on by clicking the X in the upper right-hand corner. You will now be back in the Explorer page. Look for the folder called IAFSetup (on the C drive) and double-click to open it. You should see the file **IAFSetup.iaf**.

9. Place your mouse cursor over the file, and click the right button.

10. A menu of choices should appear - choose the **Rename** option, as shown below:



11. After selecting the **Rename** option, the file should be highlighted with an edit box around it. Change the extension "**iaf**" to "**exe**", as shown below (If you make a mistake, press the **ESC** key to restore the original filename, and rename the file again):



12. Press **ENTER**. When a message appears which asks you to confirm this change, click on the Yes button. At this point, the file should be named **IAFSetup.exe**.


13. (**XP users** may skip to step 14) With your left mouse button, double-click the **IAFSetup.exe** filename. Then click on the **Unzip** button and the files that will be used for the installation will now be

extracted and made available in the IAFSetup directory. When a Winzip Self-Extractor message appears, click on the **OK button** or press Enter. Click the **Close** button to close the Winzip Self-Extractor window.

Vista users, if the Winzip application does not open up, then select "Run" to run the application and for the security warning select "Allow". Now you should be able to access the Winzip application. Select the Unzip button.



14. With your left mouse button, double-click the **setup.exe** file.



15. The installation will begin, as shown below. Follow the on-screen instructions until finished.

Vista users should select "Allow" if you get any security warnings.



16. After installation, to start the IAF software, click on the **Start button**, which is usually located at the lower-left on your Windows desktop screen (For **XP** you must also click on the "**All Programs**" item on the Start menu). Then from the pop-up list, click on the **Ohio flag, ICF_MR** icon. The IAF program will start.

17. If you wish to add a **desktop icon** on your Windows desktop from which to start the IAF program, click on the **Start button** (For **XP** you must also click the "**All Programs**" item on the Start menu).

Vista users should click on the Windows icon button which is at the same location as the start button.

With the right mouse button, click on the **Ohio flag, ICF_MR** icon which appears in the pop-up list. Then select "**Send To**" and then select "**Desktop (create shortcut)**". You should now have an **Ohio flag, ICF_MR** icon on your Windows desktop screen.
