## **OHIO MEDICAID MANAGED CARE ENROLLMENT CENTER SUMMARY**

### *Introduction*

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) operates the Ohio Medicaid Managed Care program in all eighty-eight Ohio counties. ODJFS currently contracts with seven managed care plans (MCPs), licensed as health insuring corporations through the Ohio Department of Insurance. The MCPs provide all Medicaid-covered services, assure access to quality health care, emphasize preventive care, and provide case management services to Healthy Start, Healthy Families eligibles (Ohio Works First [OWF], Healthy Start including SCHIP, and Low Income Families) and certain ABD eligibles (Aged, Blind or Disabled).

County-based outreach/education and MCP enrollment services for eligibles in all counties are the responsibility of the Medicaid Managed Care Enrollment Center Contractor, currently Automated Health Systems, (AHS). Eligibles can access the MCEC and enrollment services by phone, face to face, internet or by mail.

Eligibles in the above categories residing in **Mandatory** counties must select an MCP or be assigned to one. In the interest of continuity of care, assignment in mandatory counties is based on available previous MCP or Medicaid fee-for-service (FFS) utilization history.

MCP members in mandatory counties may change MCPs during their initial three months of membership, or during an open enrollment month.

The following monthly enrollment reports summarize MCEC data by enrollment **method** (by phone, face to face, or by mail), by enrollment **type** (FFS to MCP, MCP to MCP), in statewide, region, county and MCP formats. The May 2011 Aggregate Assignment Report utilizes MCEC-processed assignment data and ODJFS Monthly Membership Roster (MMR) enrollment data to provide aggregate assignment rates for mandatory counties. Methodology is given as part of the report.
