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OVERVIEW

Measurement Data Sources

Timeliness of Encounter Data Submission: Beginning in March 2015 for claims paid in January 2015, MCPs must report the monthly numerator and denominator for the measure on a monthly basis to ODM.

Encounter Submissions Per Encounter Schedule: MITS reports on the number of submitted and accepted encounters per managed care plan.

Timeliness of Encounter Data Submission

Measure: The percentage of encounters that are submitted to ODM and accepted within 35 calendar days of the month in which they were paid. (e.g., claims paid by the MCP in January 2015 would be reported after March 7th 2015).

Numerator: The number of claims submitted and accepted into MITS within 35 calendar days of the month in which they were paid by the MCP in the reporting month.

Denominator: The number of claims paid by the MCP in the reporting month.

Encounter Submissions per Encounter Schedule

Measure: The percent of encounters listed on the Encounter Data Submission Schedule as the minimum amount for that month that were submitted to ODM and accepted.

Numerator: The number of encounters submitted and accepted to MITS per claim type as required in the denominator.

Denominator: The minimum number of encounters per claim type required to be submitted during the month per the *Encounter Data Submission Schedule*.
