## Medicaid Buy-In for Workers with Disabilities

**Ohio Medicaid's Buy-In for Workers with Disabilities program provides health care coverage to certain working Ohioans.**

The program makes it possible for some Ohioans living with disabilities to work and keep their health care coverage.

- Who is eligible?**  
You may be eligible for the program if you are:
- » a resident of Ohio and meet U.S. citizenship requirements;
  - » between 16 to 64 years old;
  - » living with a disability as defined by the Social Security Administration (SSA);
  - » employed in paid full or part time work;
  - » within the financial guidelines of the program.

**Premiums**  
Some individuals enrolled on the program may have to pay a monthly premium. This payment may be required if you have an annual income or assets that are more than what the program allows.
